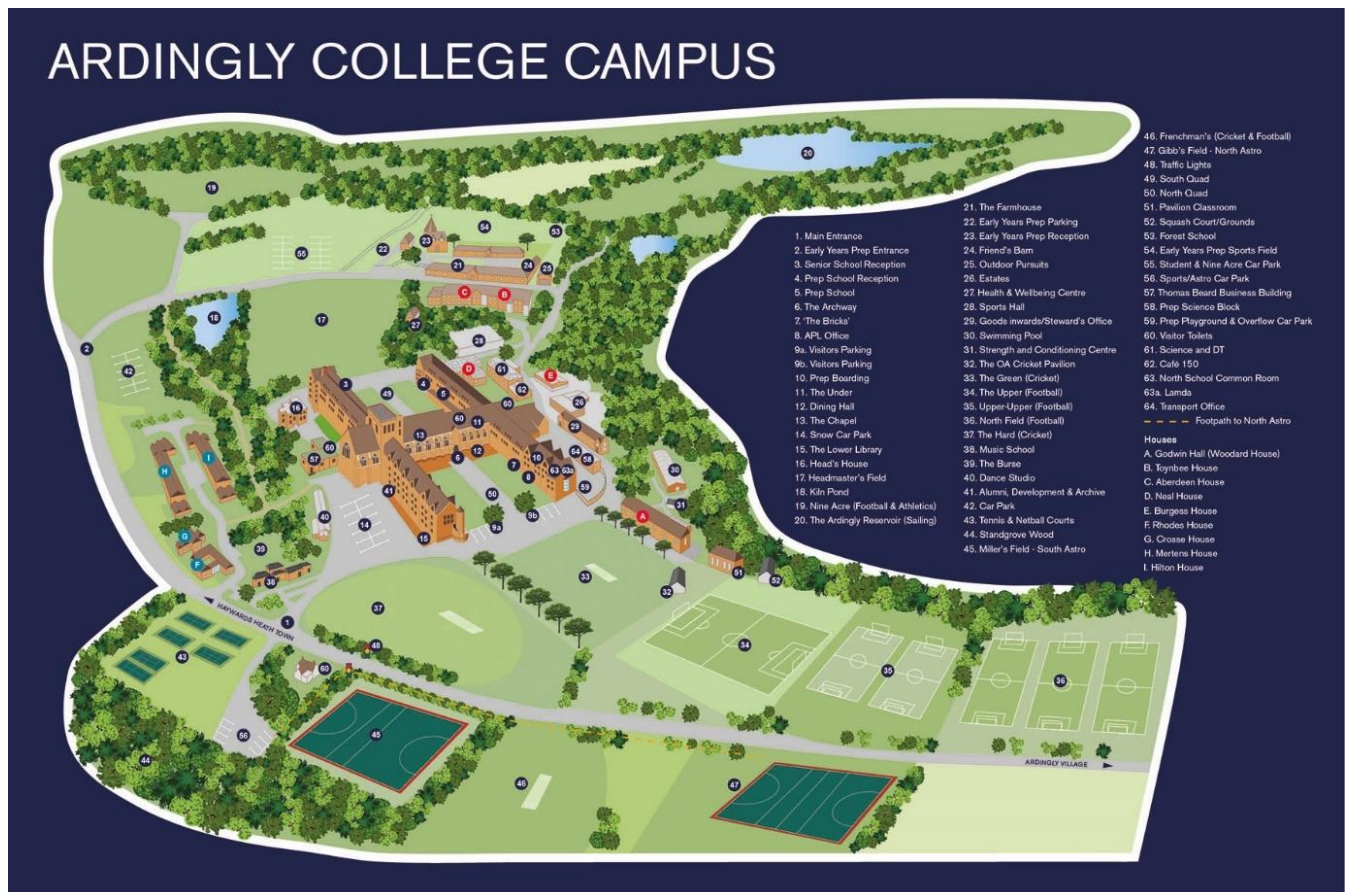
Training Camp - Fact Sheet

Location

The Training Camp is being held at: -

Ardingly College
Haywards Heath
West Sussex
RH17 6SQ

Transport – Into Camp

If you are landing at Heathrow, the college has recommended that everyone get a National Express Bus from Heathrow to Gatwick. These buses leave from Terminal 2. There is a free inter-terminal bus. You will need a ticket for this transfer that can be obtained from a ticket machine.

From Gatwick, you can get a taxi to Ardingly College. The taxi company website quotes a fixed price of £40 from Gatwick to Hayward Heath. I can't imagine it will be too much more to the college.

The price list above also lists the prices from Heathrow (horribly expensive) and Brighton, for those not travelling direct from the airport.

You may wish to tell the taxi driver of the following, extracted from the college website: -

Please be careful when using satellite navigation to get to Ardingly College, this can sometimes route you down narrow country lanes.

When arriving from the north via the M23, please exit at junction 10 not 10a, your satellite navigation should then re-route you via the A264, B2028 and College Road as described above.

Check-In

The taxi should drop you outside the main building of the college. Apparently, you go in and advise of your arrival and that you are part of the Hockey Australia Masters booking. Any issues, message me and I will have worked out check-in, particularly if you arrive later in the evening.

Accommodation

We will be staying in Crosse House. This is dormitory style accommodation. All beds are either singles or bunks. I have attached a floor plan as a separate PDF for your reference. I have already provided the college with a list of attendees, including family. I am not sure if rooms will be pre-allocated but hope that showing family that are travelling together, they will ensure you get adjoining rooms.

Laundry

We should have access to a washing machine and dryer to do our own laundry.

Meals

All meals will be taken in the Dining Hall (Marker # 12 on the campus map). The menu has been provided and sent to all players.

Alcohol

Alcohol is allowed in the dorm but only for private use. Whilst we can have it in the common room, there may be under-age staff on site, and we need to ensure we are not overtly drinking. I am sure this will not be an issue but thought I would add it for clarity.

Pool/Strength & Conditioning Room

Training Gear

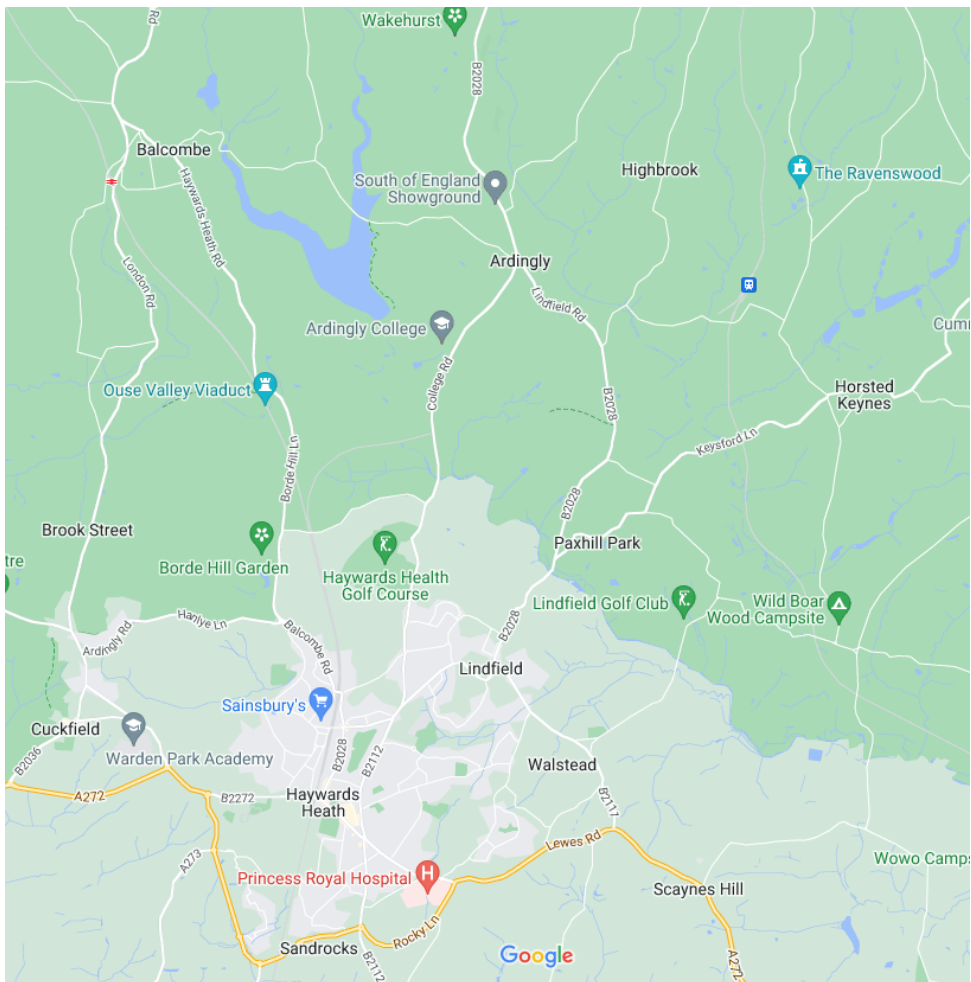
All training, including our matches will be in our training gear. Our playing shirts and shorts should be reserved for our World Cup matches.
